

Memorandum of Understanding

Between
**DMT-Gesellschaft für Lehre und Bildung mbH –
TECHNISCHE HOCHSCHULE GEORG AGRICOLA, BOCHUM, GERMANY**
And
DNİPRO UNİVERSİTY OF TECHNOLOGY, DNİPRO CİTY, UKRAİNE

This document is to confirm the foundation of a co-operation between the Technische Hochschule Georg Agricola, Bochum, Germany and the Dnipro University of Technology, Dnipro, Ukraine. The collaboration between the two universities is aimed at developing, promoting and strengthening mutual cultural relations, scientific research and the mobility of students and lecturers.

The two universities agree on the following items:

I (Aims)

The parties herewith agree to join their efforts regarding the realization of:

- a- sharing seminars and study courses, program for professional certified qualification,
- b- exchanging of academic and teaching staff (Prof., Doz., Dr., Researchers) of both parties.
- c- exchanging of graduate and postgraduate students for projects, bachelor and master thesis or in exchange students status,
- d- execution of common traineeships, seminars, conferences and workshops
- e- preparation and execution of research projects in the context of programs which are financed by organizations and/or enterprises.

II (Coordinator)

Each party will appoint one coordinator to organise conditions of collaboration who will also be responsible for the implementation.

These two coordinators should be appointed as soon as possible.

III

(Cooperation areas)

The fields (course of studies, major subjects) to have collaborative studies as agreed by both parties are as follows:

Geo Resources and Process Engineeringk

Mechanical Engineering and Applied Material Sciences

Electrical Engineering, Information Technology and Business Engineering

Research Center of Post-Mining

IV

(Student Mobility)

- a- The exchange of graduate and postgraduate students shall consider their qualification level and be carried out with the yearly numbers agreed by both parties. The activities carried out during academic mobility will be recognized according to the internal rules of each one of the universities, not giving right to obtain a diploma at the host university. The student will be subject to the internal rules of the host university during his period of academic mobility.
- b- In any case it shall be tried to get supported by national and/or international organizations and companies.
- c- Students participating in the exchange will be exempted from any regular tuition fees at the host institution. The student remains enrolled at his home university for the entire period of mobility.
- d. The student has to be formally nominated by his or her university of origin.
- e. - Present a work plan according to the curricular characteristics of the study program of both universities, which must be approved by the competent department / program of the host university before starting the mobility.
- f. Demonstrate sufficient knowledge of the language of the host university, according to the type of mobility that is to be carried out. The academic department / program of the host university may require international proficiency certificate, virtual interview or other evidence of language competence necessary for the accomplishment of mobility
- g- The travel expenses should be covered by visiting student or by sending party,
- h- Each party agrees to help the visiting students to obtain suitable accomodation. Both parties try to find additional donor to cover the costs of accomodation and living expenses.

V

(Teaching and academic staff mobility)

- a- The exchange of academic and teaching staff, researchers and experts shall be carried out in confirmity with the yearly number agreed by both parties.
- b- In any case it shall be tried to get supported by national and/or international organizations and companies.

- c- The travel expenses should be covered by the visiting teaching and academic staff.
- d- Each party agrees to help the visiting academic staff to find suitable accommodation. Both parties try to find additional donor to cover the costs of accommodation and living expenses.

VI

(Insurance)

Every person is responsible for taking out their own insurance for illness, accident, permanent disability and death. This also applies to all follow up costs such as home transportation, etc.

VII


(Coming into effect, Ending)

This agreement will come into effect with the date of the signature by the two university leaders and will last for two years period. The contract automatically extends year by year without any special notification. Each party shall have the right to cancel this agreement any time giving at least 30 days notice.

VIII

(Language)

This agreement is documented and written in the English language in two copies (one for every party) that have same legal validity.
