



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
RIGA AERONAUTICAL INSTITUTE
(RIGA, REPUBLIC OF LATVIA)
AND
DNIPRO UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY
(DNIPRO, UKRAINE)**

In order to establish direct and mutually beneficial cooperation in the field of higher academic education, science and culture and to increase the effectiveness of educational, methodological and scientific research work,

Riga Aeronautical Institute, represented by **Rector Anatolijjs Melnis**, acting under the Regulations on the one side, and **Dnipro University of Technology**, represented by **Rector Prof. Oleksandr Aziukovskyi**, acting under the Statute on the other side, jointly referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party", have entered into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter the "Memorandum") as follows:

Article 1

The purpose of this Memorandum is to strengthen, develop and extend academic cooperation in the fields of education, science and culture and to promote mutual understanding between the Parties.

Article 2

With the intention of implementing the goals of this Memorandum, the Parties have generally agreed to cooperate with each other in the following areas:

1. academic exchange of teachers, researchers, doctoral students and graduate students for the purposes of education, long-term and short-term internship, educational and scientific practice and training, professional practice;
2. cooperation in the preparation of highly qualified educational and scientific staff and specialists in the fields of mutual interest;
3. invitation for the representatives of the Parties to read lectures, exchange of experience and information in educational, methodological work and exchange of educational projects and programmes;
4. organizing and conducting lectures, work-shops (including online) by professors and administrative staff of the Parties;
5. organizing scientific joint research, conferences, seminars, symposia, round tables, days which are devoted to the Parties and other similar scientific actions and initiatives in the field of education and science. The result of joint research activities and other initiatives in the field of



education, including publications in peer-reviewed scientific journals to be added in the world's leading databases;

6. exchanges of publications, scientific research, educational and methodological literature, periodicals and information about ongoing activities;
7. preparation of joint applications for giving grants in the framework of the educational programme of the parties;
8. informing the Parties about upcoming international fairs and exhibitions, conferences, seminars or other scientific events of mutual interest organized by the Parties.

Article 3

The terms of the activities defined in Article 2 will be determined by separate agreements between the Parties.

Article 4

The cost and expenses to be paid and other financial terms in relation to any cooperation or collaboration envisaged under this Memorandum shall be subject to further detailed arrangements to be agreed between the Parties when they arise.

The Parties consider attracting potential financial partners, including public, international and other funds if possible.

Article 5

This Memorandum may be amended or modified by a written additional agreement, which will be an undivided part of the Memorandum and which must be properly registered and signed by the representatives of both Parties.

Article 6

Both Parties agree to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of their respective universities and countries.

Disputes arising in accordance with the Memorandum will be resolved by consultation and conversation between Parties.

Article 7

Each Party shall designate a staff member or office to serve as liaison for furthering the initiatives related to this Memorandum:

Article 8

This Memorandum becomes valid and into effect on the day of its signing by the statutory representatives of the Parties. It shall be effective for a period of five years unless it is terminated by one of the Parties upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six months before the termination date.

The Memorandum may be extended with the written consent of both Parties upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six months before the end of the validity period.

Article 9

The Memorandum is prepared in English in two original copies, one signed copy for each Party, all having the same legal force.
