

**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Tokyo City University, Japan
and
Dnipro University of Technology, Ukraine**

In order to encourage closer academic ties, Tokyo City University and Dnipro University of Technology enter into an agreement of cooperation to establish programs of exchange and collaboration in areas of interest and benefit to both universities. This agreement will serve as a general framework for cooperation between the two universities and is intended to facilitate discussions of more specific programs of collaboration. In particular, the two universities agree:

1. to identify opportunities for exchange of faculty and research staff;
2. to establish programs that will enable interested and qualified students and university personnel to pursue either short-term or extended programs of study in each other's universities and to facilitate visits by authorized officials from each university for the purpose of studying the other's educational system in order to develop cooperative mechanisms and to expand areas of cooperation;
3. to identify opportunities for joint research and academic activities;
4. to identify other areas of possible interest and collaboration;
5. to make faculties and students aware of the academic programs, research institutes, and educational resources of each other's universities;
6. to exempt exchange faculty, staff, and students of tuition and other scholastic fees incurred at the other university.

A designated person at each university shall oversee and facilitate implementation of this agreement in cooperation with other appropriate administrators at the respective universities.

Both universities understand that all financial arrangements will depend upon availability of funds in each specific case, which may be collaboratively and/or separately sought by both universities.

The present Memorandum comes into effect from the date of its signature by the parties and will remain valid for the period of five (5) years. Either university wishing to terminate this agreement shall notify the other university in writing at least six (6) months prior to termination. Such notification shall not affect the status of students and university personnel who have already been accepted for programs initiated prior to the termination of this agreement. Any decision to renew or renegotiate the terms of this agreement shall be made on the basis of consultations between the two universities.

The agreement should be concluded in two original documents, both written in English language and being equally authentic.

This Memorandum of Understanding is a manifestation of the intent of the parties and does not create any legal obligation between the parties.
